RECREATION PROJECTS

- US BICYCLE ROUTE 90 REALIGNMENT: The Board approved realigning USBR 90 through Jackson County, shifting the route to Reddoch/Blue Springs Road. The County will install new signage to enhance visibility and accessibility for cyclists.
- SHANGRI LA ELEVATED BOARDWALK: The Board awarded the Shangri La Boardwalk project to Monolith Construction for \$428,244, funded by an FDEP grant. The project includes an elevated boardwalk and viewing platform, improving public access to Shangri La Spring.
- CYPRESS PARK IMPROVEMENTS: The Board approved an FDEP grant to fund upgrades at Cypress Park, including: New Plagrounds, Outdoor Restroom Facility, Expanded Trails, Enhanced Security Measures.



COURTROOM DEDICATIONS

The Board adopted resolutions to name two courtrooms after distinguished judges:

- The Circuit Courtroom at the Jackson County Courthouse is now the Judge Robert L. McCrary, Jr., Courtroom.
