Scheduled Water Service Interruption and Booster Pump Installation in Indian Springs **Subdivision**



Jackson County, FL – Jackson County Utilities is committed to improving water service for our residents. To increase and stabilize water pressure in the Indian Springs subdivision, a water booster pump installation has been rescheduled for Tuesday, January 14, 2025.

Utility crews discovered an unmarked utility line during preliminary work on Tuesday January 7, 2025, causing a temporary delay in the installation. The unmarked line has since been relocated, and the project is ready to proceed as planned.

Water service in Indian Springs will be temporarily interrupted from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM on Tuesday, January 14, 2025 to complete the installation. Once service is restored, a precautionary boil water notice will be in effect until required

testing confirms the water is safe to drink. Residents will be notified via an additional press release once the notice is lifted.
