<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Non-metal furniture (sofas, bookcases, etc.) • Rugs and carpet (please roll and tie) • Mattresses and box springs • Bathroom fixtures (non-metal tubs, sinks, toilets) • Mirrors or glass tabletops (must be covered with newspaper and taped to prevent breakage) • Large non-metal toys • Plastic trash cans • Five or more bags or cans of household trash 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tires • White goods/appliances • Construction debris • Hazardous materials (paint cans, chemicals, oil, or fuel)

Please note: There will be no staff on site. Residents are responsible for unloading and placing items into dumpsters. Be sure to bring adequate help if disposing of heavy or bulky materials.
